

# SkinQRx Hydrafix MediFacial Kit

## OBJECTIVE

### Primary —

To study the moisturizing effect of SKINQ Rx Hydrafix MediFacial Kit.

### Secondary —

- Skin lightness — tan reduction
- Skin glow and radiance
- Skin smoothness
- Skin elasticity

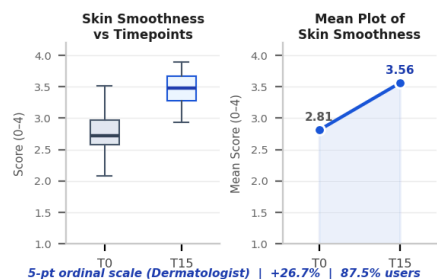
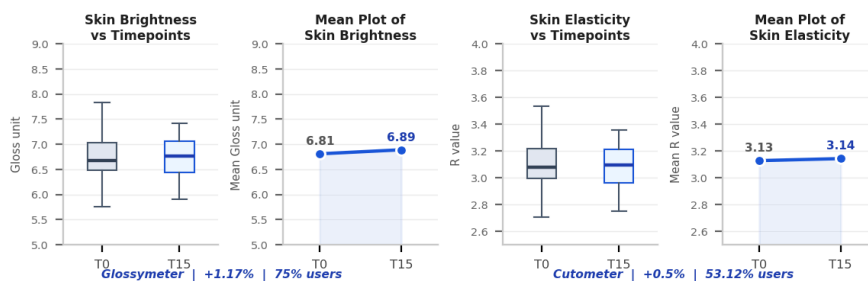
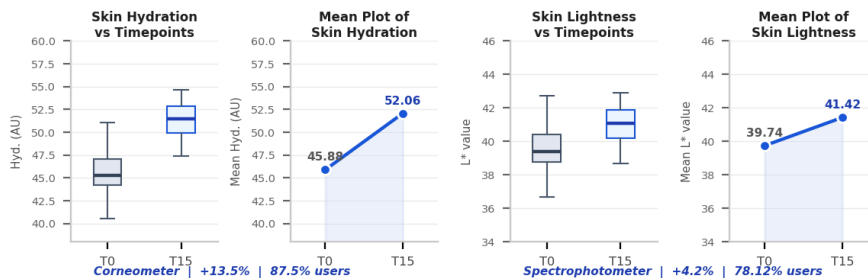
## INCLUSION CRITERIA

- Non-pregnant, non-lactating female, age 25–45
- Willing to give written informed consent
- Women of childbearing potential — negative UPT required
- Free of any systemic or dermatologic disorder
- Willing to avoid prolonged UV exposure during study

## RESULTS

- **+13.5%** hydration in 15 mins (87.5% users)
- **+4.2%** skin lightness in 15 mins (78.12% users)
- **+1.17%** brightness/gloss in 15 mins (75% users)
- **+0.5%** skin elasticity in 15 mins (53.12% users)
- **+26.7%** smoothness in 15 mins (87.5% users)
- **100%** panel — zero side effects reported
